1.	Matters arising from Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held on 11 July 2022: Terms of Reference for
	the Neighbourhood Planning Group was approved by the Parish Council
2.	Welcome and Attendees: Members of the public were welcomed to the meeting and thanked for
	volunteering. Maria Vonsova Parish Clerk has asked to step down from her duties as Secretary for the
	Neighbourhood Planning Group. Mr Nelson added a request for volunteers for the role of the Parish
	Neighbourhood Planning secretary.
3.	<b>Terms of Reference:</b> Terms of Reference approved by the Parish Council were discussed, in particular
	that recommendations made by the group are taken to the Parish Council for decision. Terms were
	supported by the group.
4.	<b>Dates for Neighbourhood Planning Meetings:</b> Dates for 2022 are proposed as September 26 <sup>th</sup> and
	November 28 <sup>th</sup> . Dates for 2023 are proposed as January 16 <sup>th</sup> and thereafter to be the Monday two weeks
	before the main Grafton Parish Council Meeting
5.	Neighbourhood Plan Community Survey: Mr Pash shared the proposed community survey. The group
	discussed the importance of getting as many people across the parish to respond. There were various
	suggestions, included publishing in the community news, offering printed copies to those in the
	community that needed, using the list of older residents from Jubilee day. To publish on village
	WhatsApp groups in August and a reminder in September with the 20th Sept as a deadline.
	Action: Mr Pash to update on the process and results of Neighbourhood Planni on the next Parish
	Meeting.
6.	Synopsis of the process of Neighbourhood Planning: Mr Pash shared an overview of the process for
	Neighbourhood planning including the need to put all proposals to the community as a referendum
	when they are ready. Mr Pash shared an overview of the report on the Vision Meeting held on April 25 <sup>th</sup>
	with members of the Parish, the group agreed that the report was a fair reflection of the discussion on
	April 25 <sup>th</sup> . Mr Pash also shared progress on the Parish website <u>www.graftonparish.com</u> which now has a
	section on Neighbourhood Plan added to it and a welcome to members of the public who may want to
	join the group.
