You are all very welcome - please bring a sturdy pair of gloves - we'll provide everything else.







Around 100 areas have been identified where these savings can be made and, unfortunately, one of these means that residents are now to be charged for collection of their garden waste (our green bins). It is thought the cost could be around £40 a year per household.
