I qualified as a GP in 2000 and I have been a partner in a busy suburban practice in Dunfermline, just north of Edinburgh, for nearly 13 years. A carer is anyone who cares, unpaid, for a family member or friend who cannot manage without their support. They might look after someone with a physical disability, long term health condition, mental health issue or a problem with substance misuse.

Carer Support Wiltshire is a local charity supporting carers in Wiltshire. They help them to access support, information, services, education and training, and breaks from their caring role. Their Carer Cafes and Support Groups are held throughout the county and offer friendly advice, help and opportunities to meet other carers and chat over a cuppa.
