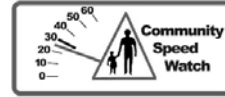

Our Doctor writes

Dr. Angela Paddon has asked me to write an introduction about myself for this month's issue, and I decided the best place to start was at the beginning. I was born and brought up in Edinburgh and studied medicine at Aberdeen University before moving back to Edinburgh to complete my post graduate training, my junior doctor years, in Central Scotland. I qualified as a GP in 2000 and I have been a partner in a busy suburban practice in Dunfermline, just north of Edinburgh, for nearly 13 years. We decided as a family to move down to Wiltshire, with the promise of sun and warmer weather and a more relaxed pace of life. So far it hasn't disappointed...except for the odd day of very heavy rain!

I joined the Old School Surgery at the beginning of April and have been overwhelmed with how welcome everyone has made me feel. Both the staff and patients have been very patient and kind with me as I navigate a new computer system and complicated hospital network. I have also taken over the Vernham Dean Surgery on Thursday afternoons.

I hope to be able to continue the enthusiasm that Dr. Tim Ballard had for medical student and GP registrar training. I have been a Clinical Tutor for both Aberdeen and St Andrews Universities for a number of years, and intend to put this to good use when the practice has medical students attached from Bristol University and GP registrars. I encourage everybody to make them welcome as these young students are hopefully the GPs of the future and we have to do our best to encourage them to consider a career in General Practice.

Finally the practice has had its Care Quality Commission (CQC) inspection. It went very well but we are still awaiting the final report which we will update you with in due course.

Do you look after someone?

As our population ages and people live longer, often with complex health conditions, more and more of us will find ourselves caring for someone, with 3 in 5 of us becoming carers at some point in our lives. A carer is anyone who cares, unpaid, for a family member or friend who cannot manage without their support. They might look after someone with a physical disability, long term health condition, mental health issue or a problem with substance misuse.

Carer Support Wiltshire is a local charity supporting carers in Wiltshire. They help them to access support, information, services, education and training, and breaks from their caring role. Their Carer Cafes and Support Groups are held throughout the county and offer friendly advice, help and opportunities to meet other carers and chat over a cuppa.
