Great Bedwyn Surgery - Our doctor writes

Everything is changing on a daily basis and by the time you read this article in your Parish magazine the advice here may have changed again. There is a lot of information available on the NHS and Public Health England websites and I would encourage you to look at these websites if you are concerned about your health and whether you are suffering from symptoms of COVID-19. The most current information about what to do can be found on these sites. At the time of writing this article the advice is to stay socially isolated for 7 days if you have a fever above 37.8 and/or a new persistent cough or 14 days if you live with someone who has a fever and a new cough. If you are unwell with difficulty breathing you need to call 111.

I would like to explain about the changes in GP practice in response to this pandemic. This affects all GP practices not just The Old School Surgery at Great Bedwyn. Before I do this though, I would like to thank all of the patients who have been affected by the sudden changes to the way we practice for their understanding, patience and for the offers of help we have received so that we can continue to provide a community service.

NHS England has advised all GP practices to change to a telephone appointment triage system. The ability to book your appointment online has been suspended. This is to minimise the number of patients coming into practices and reduce the risk of exposing the practice staff and patients in the waiting room to the virus. We are trying to keep everyone safe. Do not come to the surgery if you have a fever or a new persistent cough. If you need to come the initial point of contact is now via the window at the rear of the surgery. If you are invited into the building, use the hand sanitizer before entering and try to stay at least a meter away from anyone in the waiting room and staff. I'm sure you can appreciate it that if members of the Practice team become unwell we will struggle to provide a service. At present at The Old School Surgery we have one doctor who is unable to work because a family member is unwell and she has had to self-isolate. Dr Hannah Graystone is pregnant and cannot work at the surgery as she is considered high risk. In the next few days we hope to have remote access systems in place so the staff can work from home.

Please telephone the surgery for an appointment. In order to establish whether you need a same day urgent telephone appointment or a routine telephone appointment you may need to give the receptionist some information about the reason you are calling. A doctor or nurse will call you as close to your appointment time as possible. If you require an examination, blood test, other investigation or treatment, the doctor will arrange a time for a face to face appointment. Those of you needing wound dressings or monitoring blood tests because you are on certain medicines still need to have these done, so do call for an appointment.

The dispensary team at The Old School Surgery have been exceptionally busy over the last few days. Many of you are requesting medication early just in case you have to self-isolate. Please be considerate and order your medication as you normally would. Supplies of certain medicines are already reduced and everyone needs their medicines. The surgery is exploring ways to deliver your medicine should you need to self-isolate. You may still collect medicine if you are well.

If you have a hospital appointment or procedure the hospital will contact you. Further information can be found on relevant the hospital's website. For GWH this is www.gwh.nhs.uk.

I would encourage everyone to think about reducing their social interactions. Please consider whether it is absolutely necessary to go to your GP practice or local village shops. Consider the effect on the community if these vital resources had to close because of illness.

Community Safety Update - Grafton burglar caught

Following the news of additional requirement on resources for Wiltshire Constabulary, it has been confirmed that 37 newly qualified Police Officers will be joining later this month.

They will be split between Swindon and Wiltshire divisions, with deployment across the County's Community Policing Teams - meeting the objective to increase Police visibility throughout our rural areas.

Very good news to report - the perpetrator of at least one of East Grafton's burglaries is now behind bars, having confessed to no less than 75 such crimes - involving stolen goods to a value in excess of half a million pounds.

Parish Council planning meetings are suspended

Planning applications continue to be processed by Wiltshire Council with this statement of procedures:

"As our applications are available online, you will still be able to view the plans and details and will hopefully be able to adapt new ways of working to communicate your views to us. As this is an ongoing national situation we hope you will understand that we are unable to freeze planning applications, particularly given the need to keep economic activity moving.

We have had a high percentage of applications dealt with under delegated powers for a long time, and this will continue. At present we are currently reviewing the position regarding the holding of planning committees and will advise you if this impacts on your applications."
