# Grafton Parish Council Neighbourhood Plan

Over the last few years, there have been **big improvements to Grafton Parish** to make it a great place to live. Think of the difference that our Coronation Hall has made to the community, or the hard work put into restoring Wilton Windmill. Other volunteers have helped transform our broadband supply in Wexcombe and Marten, and now connect our homeworkers in meetings from Zurich to New York!

Most changes require **planning and development approval with Wiltshire Council**. For example, a proposed development for Machinery field in Grafton, supported by the Parish, was unsuccessful at planning stage. So we need to take a structured approach, and will be working with **Andrea Pellegram**, an experienced manager and town planner (**www.pellegram.co.uk**).

In next few months we will be **writing a Neighbourhood Plan for Grafton,** thinking about changes that we can make together over the next 5 to 10 years. The work on Neighbourhood plan will create a kind of central blueprint for our work as a Council – this will lead to individual actions that will follow the usual planning processes.

# Vision Meeting - 25 April at 7pm at the Coronation Hall in Grafton

To kick things off, there will be a meeting open to all residents where we want to gather your ideas and thoughts on the topics below, which we are calling our "Vision Meeting" and will be run with Parish Council Members and with Andrea. During the meeting we will explain the approach we will follow and how we will take your ideas and recommendations into account.

Living We think Grafton Parish is a wonderful place to live, however there may be <b>small changes</b> we should consider. We think that being proactive in our development plans, we can carefully develop the area, maintaining its character and charm.	In the past few years, and with the support of the community, we have <b>proposed developments</b> in a few of places in the parish which were unsuccessful at planning stage with Wiltshire Council.
Working The impact of COVID-19 will change the way many of us work, with more of us working from home.	Many homes in the parish now have <b>fast broadband</b> . Through a community application we have fibre to the premise (1Gb/s) in Marten and Wexcombe. Another group are pursuing this for West and East Grafton.
<b>Getting about</b> Most of us travel by car rather than on public transport or by bicycle. For a rural area the roads are fast.	Our speedwatch scheme shows motorists are driving in an increasingly dangerous way through the parish, reaching 65mph in Grafton.
There are big changes coming to the way we travel, with no new petrol or diesel cars on sale from 2030.	• There has been good redevelopment and improvement of tracks and paths.
Community Resources For a small community we have a number of resources to feel really proud about.	With your help we have created the Coronation Hall, we have the excellent Sunflowers Nursery, the support groups for the COVID pandemic, our clubs, Wilton Windmill
Environment We live in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB).  There have been many improvements over the past few years.  Protecting and supporting this is something we can all play a role in.	An impressive 25,000 acres of local farmland is part of the Southern Streams Initiative     www.southernstreams.co.uk. This commits to enrich the landscape and biodiversity on our environment, whilst enhancing water quality in the rivers, streams, lakes and ponds.




