## Parish Council update

**Planning meetings** have been held at 1pm in the Coronation Hall in the past. These days the Hall is regularly booked at this time and so the meeting times have had to be changed. From 9 August the Parish Council planning meetings will be held, when there are plans to discuss, prior to the full Parish Council meeting, at Wilton Manor Farm Barn. All planning applications, for non-tree work, are posted on our Facebook and Twitter accounts (see page 4 for details). Meetings will be open to the public as before and the agendas for planned meetings will be posted on noticeboards and on **www.graftonparish.com** as usual.

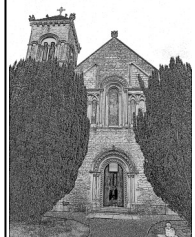
The Parish Council will do all that it can to ensure that planning dates are adjusted to coincide with full Council meetings as before. It is important to note that there is no requirement for "Applications for Tree work" to be discussed at open meetings therefore the Parish Councillor(s) responsible for the hamlet involved will respond to Wiltshire County Council. Please be warned that if a tree application affects your property it is your responsibility to respond to the application on the Planning website **www.unidoc.wiltshire.gov.uk/uniDoc** - this is the web site for investigating all planning applications.

**Conservation area:** Requests have been made recently regarding the Conservation Area in our Parish. You can find out more about this at **www.graftonparish.com** - select Grafton Parish Council/Planning and scroll down to the conservation area statement. It is important to note that different rules apply to planning applications in a Conservation area and so it may well be worth a visit to the "do I need planning permission" web page on the Wiltshire website. **www.wiltshire.gov.uk/article/3586/Do-I-need-planning-permission**. Do please remember that your Parish Councillors are there to help you so please contact your local representative if you have any concerns or queries.

**Speed Watch** is resuming after a long break. From the data downloaded so far, the East Grafton Speed Indicator Devices appear to be making a difference. We always need more volunteers to man the devices which we share with Easton Royal on a fortnightly basis. It is now possible to undertake the necessary training online, rather than going to Police Headquarters in Devizes, so please consider getting involved. The equipment may not be used in rain, fog or snow so you will not be asked to stand outside in very inclement weather! There is a requirement for the Police to preform a Risk Assessment at each proposed location before the cameras can be used in an area so currently there are 3 sites only available in our Parish. Requests have been made for further sites but permission has not yet been given.

### St. Nicholas' Church update



The PCC is pleased to report that permission for internal roof repair has been granted by the Salisbury Diocese Faculty. Funding of £2,000 has now been arranged with the Wiltshire Historic Churches Trust and the PCC has received some generous donations which, together with reserve funds, will enable work to commence; although further fund raising will be required to replenish the coffers which will be significantly depleted.

Work will start as soon as scaffolders and builders are able to schedule the jobs.

#### Baton for Posterity

Everyone is welcome to write their name in permanent ink as soon as the wooden batons are ready to be placed onto the new ceiling. The repair fund will benefit from your donations (minimum £5 per baton) and the roof will provide a record of Parish residents for many years to come. These signings will take place in the lych gate at the dates and times published.

#### Autumn clean and recover

Once the ceiling has been repaired there will be a need for a team of people to wield dusters, polishers, hoovers and much else! "Sing-along-a-clean" will be advertised, coffee/tea/cakes and much more will be served to all those with willing helping hands. This will herald a new start for St Nicholas' church - gleaming roof, gleaming church and smiling friends.

#### Church Services

No services during August and then 11am on the first Sunday in each month is Holy Communion and 6pm on the fourth Sunday is time for hymn singing and the evening service. Please be aware that the areas of the church which can be used prior to ceiling repairs are clearly marked and it is important to follow the signs. It is hoped that services can be held on Sundays in the Coronation Hall if work continues into September.

## News in Brief



**Community Messaging** aims to improve the flow of information between communities and the police.

Free alerts (by email, text or voicemail) from local police officers about policing and crime matters in their Community Policing Team (CPT) area and from partner agencies.

Residents can reply to messages from local officers to help them better police the area e.g. responding to police appeals for information.

**Emergency Alerts** For example, warning of severe flooding, fires, explosions, terrorist incidents or public health emergencies.

Emergency alerts work like a radio broadcast and in an emergency, mobile phone masts in the surrounding area will broadcast an alert. Every compatible mobile phone or tablet in range of a mast will receive the alert.

The emergency services and the UK government do not need your phone number to send you an alert. You will get alerts based on your current location – not where you live or work.

No one will collect or share data about you, your device or your location when you receive an alert. You will not get alerts if your device is turned off or in aeroplane mode.

Emergency alerts are free. You do not need to sign up for them or download an app. You can opt out of some emergency alerts, but you should keep them switched on for your own safety. To find out more visit **[www.gov.uk/alerts/how-alerts-work](http://www.gov.uk/alerts/how-alerts-work)**



**Dorset & Wiltshire Fire & Rescue Safe and Well Visits** are completely free of charge.

They will supply and install free smoke, heat, and carbon monoxide alarms and also provide fire retardant bedding, spray, extension leads, heater loans, arson proof letterboxes, and deaf alerts where required.

## Local Bus Transport

Wiltshire Council is asking for help to shape the future of local bus transport, as part of the Government strategy to improve and transform services across the country.

Around £3bn has been set aside by the Government to make improvements throughout England, and Wiltshire Council is looking at how Wiltshire and our residents can benefit from this. The Government's strategy complements the council's aim to encourage more people to travel by bus to help support its carbon neutral objectives, and to reach and connect more people who live in rural communities.

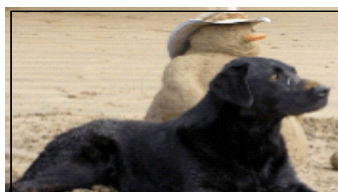
