**Our Doctor Writes** about Out of Hours (OOH) assistance, this month. Living as we do, some miles from our nearest hospitals - medical issues and emergencies can be especially worrying, particularly when the local surgeries are closed.

The **111** free non-emergency helpline is usually the best place to start - where trained medical staff will triage the patient's concerns and make recommendations for further treatment. Whilst there are Minor Injuries Units in Andover, Chippenham and Thatcham - often **111** can arrange a convenient appointment time with an Out of Hours Doctor at Savernake Hospital in Marlborough. More information about OOH is available on **www.theburbagesurgery.co.uk**, but a call to **111** can result in medical support for non-emergency conditions being available far sooner than a trip to GWH A&E.

### Alabama rot disease in dogs - a warning

Cutaneous Renal and Glomerular Vasculopathy (CRGV), commonly known as 'Alabama rot' is a disease that damages blood vessels in the skin and kidneys and can affect dogs of any breed, age or size. Dogs reported with the disease can suffer kidney failure and/or skin lesions.

There have been a small number of vet confirmed cases in Wiltshire. The most recent case involves the sad death of a dog who it is reported was walked along the canal side in Lyneham and in Crudwell. Many thousands of dogs are walked in the countryside every day and it is important to remember that only a very small number of dogs have been affected. Case numbers have increased in recent years; however, it is hoped this is due a higher level of awareness of the disease.

As the cause for Alabama rot remains unknown dog owners are not currently being advised to avoid any particular locations and testing to date has not revealed whether there is an environmental trigger. No vaccination for Alabama rot is available.


