
COMMUNITY NEWS



For those of you unfamiliar with parkrun it is a simple formula of free, weekly, timed 5km events for all ages from 4+ across the country and even internationally now. It is important to say these are not races. You don't have to be able to run 5km, you can jog, walk or even stroll it. They are open to all.

All you have to do is register, print off your personal barcode and head down to Marlborough Common for 9am on Saturdays. Christmas Turkeys

This year St Nicholas' Church and Manor Farm will once again be supplying local turkeys (all reared and prepared within 20 miles of East Grafton) and donating all the profit from the sales to St Nicholas' Church and Wiltshire Air Ambulance. Every \pounds of profit will go to charity so it is one way of enjoying a fabulous local turkey and donating to two local causes at the same time.

There are 3 types of bird available:

Organic Free Range Bronze Turkeys to Soil Association Standards

Free Range Bronze Turkeys
Traditional Barn Reared Farm Fresh Turkeys



The Organic birds are reared by local farmers in Vernham Dean and the others are reared on a farm high up on the Berkshire Downs by Ed Walters of Walters Turkeys. All are reared to high welfare standards in spacious airy barns with a deep straw bed with lots of perches. The Organic and Free Range have access to large grass paddocks to roam over during the day. The Organic birds have been fed on a fully organic diet.

All the birds are allowed to grow slowly and mature naturally before they are traditionally prepared by Ed Walters and his team. They will be dry plucked and hand finished before being hung for at least 7 days and come wrapped in greaseproof paper and boxed with vacuum packed giblets and a free pop up timer. The careful rearing and processing gives a, tender and full of flavour, really traditional turkey

News in Brief

Everleigh Household Recycling Centre

Unfortunately, despite 94% of consultation responses in favour of keeping the centre open, Wiltshire Council has decided to close Everleigh Household Recycling Centre on 6 November.

The decision was based on the number of visits, regardless of the demographic area each centre served. Pewsey Community Area Partnership is currently waiting to hear whether the consultation process can be challenged legally. The nearest other centres are Marlborough and Devizes. Light Pollution - Message from a resident

We all feel the benefit of external lighting at this time of year. Our movement sensitive and timed lighting help keep us safe as the nights draw in but do take a few moments to consider if the light may be a bit of a nuisance for your neighbours. Our limited street lighting means that external lights can be uncomfortably bright and sometimes light spills beyond the boundary of your property. Please ensure that your external lights are appropriately placed.

Marlborough Library

If you, a friend or relative loves reading but are unable to get to the library because of a disability, ill health, mobility issues or due to caring responsibilities at home, Wiltshire Council's home library service may be the perfect solution. The free service, which is delivered by volunteers, is available for eligible customers who have no one to visit the library for them. A member of library staff initially visits the customer at home to talk about what they would like to read. They are then introduced to a library volunteer, who will visit every few weeks to exchange their books. There are no fines or charges for this service and items can also be requested.
