St Nicholas' Church update from Martin Butt



I am very pleased to report that work on our Church ceiling has now been completed. After a long wait, caused by COVID, we were eventually able to arrange for the builders to carry out their repairs almost as soon as the scaffolding, which filled the whole nave, had been assembled. In fact the whole operation was completed in just over a week and this meant that we didn't have enough time to put our batten-signing idea into action, which would have been a nice way of involving parishioners - and of raising a bit of extra cash.

We are pleased that prudent housekeeping over the years - coupled with the help we have received from the Wiltshire Historic Churches Trust and generous donations from parishioners - meant that we were able to cover the cost of the work. However, St. Nicholas now finds itself in a precarious situation financially and so it is important to emphasise, again, how grateful we are to those who continue to support the Church through the gift aid scheme. Indeed, without their help during the last two years, when we have had no collections or fund-raising events, we would by now be in serious difficulties.



The Church has had a thorough clean and arrangements have been made to clean the windows. It looks lovely! Perhaps now that the repair work has been done we could make a fresh start in our commitment to our Church by attending some of the services coming up: remembrance, advent, carols and Christmas. I do urge you to come to Church, swell our shrinking congregation and give thanks for all the happiness we enjoy as a community. We are always very pleased to see you.

Our Doctor writes

We are experiencing a lot more viral infections currently.

The delta variant commonly presents just like a cold with a sore throat, runny nose and headache, then a cough and fever. Loss of smell and taste occur less frequently with this variant. If you develop theses symptoms please arrange a PCR test by calling 119 or going to gov.uk Covid. Lateral flow test are only 50 to 70% accurate and you need a PCR test to exclude Covid-19.

Sore throats, common colds, coughs, earaches are usually caused by viral infections that antibiotics will not treat. These illness are self-limiting and will get better on their own in a few days to a few weeks with the help of basic over the counter pain relief containing paracetamol and ibuprofen. A cough will usually go away on its own within 3 weeks.

During the last few weeks we have seen a lot of people with a cough who are concerned that they may have a chest infection. These people have acute bronchitis which often develops 1 to 2 weeks following a viral cold or sore throat. The virus causes temporary inflammation of the airways (bronchi) resulting in increased mucus production. Your body tries to shift this extra mucus through coughing. In addition to coughing, you may feel wheezy and a little more short of breath. Your chest and abdominal muscles may ache because of coughing, which is often worse on lying down and keep you and your family awake at night. You should not have a temperature/fever and can usually go about your normal activities, although you may be more tired and less hungry. Acute bronchitis is more common in winter and can affect people of all ages, but mostly affects children under five. Antibiotics are not required to treat acute bronchitis. Older people, patients on drugs which suppress the immune system (eg chemotherapy, rheumatoid arthritis drugs), patients with chronic lung and heart conditions and smokers are more vulnerable to develop chest infections caused by bacteria which antibodies will treat. If your cough is present for more than 4 weeks, especially if you are a smoker, you should see your GP to exclude another cause for your cough.
