This promises to be an evening of excellent food and drink with a large choice of dishes and all in the relaxed atmosphere of friends and families. Tickets are £15.00.

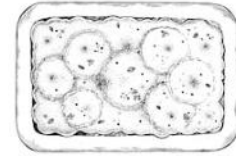

Our Farmer writes ...



With harvest done for another year and some of next year's crops already in the ground and growing, it's a chance for a short break and time to look back at the year that has just been.

Harvest started in fine, dry conditions in July and early August. We then had a very frustrating spell of nearly 3 weeks with catchy weather, during which little harvesting was done and that which was cut required the added expense of drying. We have now entered a mini Indian Summer in which to not only finish harvest but also to plant next year's Oilseed Rape. This will need close inspection as last year much of the country's crop was decimated by tiny black beetles called the "Cabbage Stem Flea Beetle" (although we were lucky to avoid almost all of this damage). There is very little chemical control to help us, as one insecticide was banned a couple of years ago and

the beetles are generally resistant to another. So in an attempt to fool them we have planted our oilseed rape with 2 companion crops, vetch and buckwheat and left the barley stubble (from the previous crop) long. This may have the effect of literally throwing them off the scent, it also benefits the soil microbes, particularly the beneficial soil fungi, which don't thrive in a monoculture of brassicas like Oilseed Rape.


The harvest in general has been a good one, Wheat yields have been very good this year, the actual weights are not all in yet, but it looks like probably being one of our best ever! The Oilseed Rape was better than average, whilst the Spring Barley and peas were around average. Sadly however, the price we're getting for everything that we have harvested this Summer is not that good (a farmer has to have something to moan about!)

We have also been busy planting Cover Crops. These are mixtures planted in the fields which will not have a cash crop planted until March next year. They will protect the soil, during a time when it would have otherwise been open to the elements, feed the below ground micro-fauna and provide some winter grazing for our cattle. The Cover Crops are diverse mixtures including mustards, radish, lupins, vetch as well as buckwheat, phacelia, linseed and oats. This diversity benefits the livestock both above AND below ground, which like us thrive on a varied diet.
