On 19 July, with the change in the Covid guidelines, appointments for face to face consultations became available on request. You can now opt to have a face to face consultation or a telephone call. Whilst many of you have continued to use the telephone triage system with all its flexibility, it is also lovely to see familiar faces again in the consulting rooms.

There have been some changes to our staff. Dr Noel Au-Yeung is now a fully qualified GP having completed her year with the practice. She will be back occasionally to locum. Dr Izabel, who spent six months with us, has moved to another practice to complete her training. We have welcomed Dr Sobia for the final year of her training and Dr Eno for six months as part of her second year attachment. We are a training practice and grateful that we have been able to continue training future GPs and medical students during the pandemic. Thank you to all of you who book appointments with our trainees and challenge them with the diversity that general practice presents.

There have also been changes to the reception team and Alex Roe is rapidly learning on the job. He is going to medical school next year and this is great experience for him. Recently, a member of the clinical team tested positive for Covid. This is the first time this has happened and it is quite amazing that a member of staff has not been infected previously. Fortunately patients were not put at risk. However, it does highlight the fact that we all still need to wear our masks, social distance, wash hands and minimise the numbers in the waiting room. So, for now, please continue to go to the back window if you do not have an appointment.

Finally I would like thank Linda Fry and Patrick Pease for all the hard work they do in the garden. It looks beautiful.
