Difficult times — but a strong Community

You may have heard that Wiltshire Council's report following the consultation on proposed closure of Grafton School was published recently with the recommendation that the School close at the end of the Summer Term.

There has been a school in Grafton Parish for over 150 years and contemplating its closure is difficult. It has been widely acknowledged that Grafton Primary School has not been the school of choice for Parish parents for many years and despite the great efforts made by staff, governors and Grafton School parents it has not been possible to secure a future for the school. Though only a small proportion of Parish children currently attend our school the closure of one of the focal points of the community will still be felt strongly across the Parish.

On a happier note, as always there are many community events happening across the Parish in the next few weeks. The Thursday Club is meeting on 21 April with drinks and food for all the family. There's family fun at the Easter Eggstravaganza on Easter Monday, street parties are taking place to celebrate the Royal Wedding, followed by the Right Royal Party at the Coronation Hall. Grafton Game Fair's family day is on 7 May and the May Food Fair at Wilton Windmill on 14 May. Lots of opportunities to enjoy Spring in our beautiful Parish.



Grafton Primary School – likely summer closure

On Monday 21 March Wiltshire Council published their report following the public consultation on the future of Grafton Primary School. There was a comprehensive response to the consultation with 213 written responses which is the largest number Wiltshire Council have received to an issue of this kind. Sadly, as no new partnership opportunities have emerged, the recommendation is that the school should close this summer and Statutory Notice to Close will shortly be published. The full report is available online at www.wiltshire.gov.uk and also on the school website www.grafton.wilts.sch.uk.

There is the opportunity to lodge an appeal against the statutory notice during the 6 week appeal period. Regrettably it seems unlikely that without significant changes in circumstances that an appeal will be successful. In the meantime the governing body continues its efforts to follow up every opportunity that may secure a future for Grafton School and is working closely with the Sunflowers Committee to establish a viable plan to enable Sunflowers to continue.

The consultation also sought views on which schools the Grafton Parish catchment area should be redesignated to, should the school close. There was an overwhelming desire from all parts of the Grafton Parish community that that the catchment be redesignated as a whole, and that links with the Great Bedwyn community and school were the strongest. Therefore it is proposed to redesignate the catchment to Great Bedwyn School.

It appears that all parties – pupils, parents, staff, governors and our wider community - are taking a pragmatic approach to the news. At school one of the first priorities is to ensure that parents are able to secure places for their children at an alternative school of their choice from September and good progress is being made with this. From the wider community perspective what happens to the buildings and land is a key question and whilst the ultimate decisions will be taken by Salisbury Diocese and Wiltshire Council who own the buildings and land respectively, the Parish Council has confirmed that it is setting up a working party for involvement in this.


