The Queen Consort visited Grafton Parish in 2010 to perform the official opening of the Coronation Hall in East Grafton. Temporary Road Closure Notice

Wiltshire Council has made the following Order to close temporarily to all traffic (Ref: TTRO 8338):

Hollow Lane (Part), Grafton; from its junction with Grafton Road for a distance of approximately 50m in a southerly direction, to enable Wiltshire Council to carry out bridge strengthening and associated works, between 7 and 25 November.

Alternative route: via Grafton Road – Wilton Road – A338 – Hollow Lane (unaffected length) and vice versa.
