A New Bus Service!



On 31 July Stage 1 of a new bus service launched which will ultimately connect the Vale of Pewsey villages with Pewsey, Devizes, Marlborough and Hungerford. Stage 2 starts on 4 September and Stage 3 starts on 30 October.

This new service offers a dual service with timetabled routes as well as a bookable bus for villages not near those routes.

There are other benefits as well, including accessibility, USB charging and (soon to come) free wi-fi. Booking can be done by phone or on an app - just search for Wiltshire Connect to download.

The service will connect with trains at Hungerford, Bedwyn and Pewsey stations and will make it easier for you to get around. As well as getting to the stations, you'll be able to visit Marlborough or Hungerford or take the bus to get to the start of a walk that you'd like to do or a village you would like to visit.

Green Open Homes Weekend

Great Green Bedwyn are looking for any homeowners who have a "Green home" and whether they might be willing to show it during the weekend of 14/15 October. The event will help people interested in installing green technologies to find out more about them without a sales pitch and also raise awareness of green homes and technologies.

The kinds of green technologies include low carbon heating systems (eg. heat pumps), energy saving (eg. super insulation), energy generation (eg. solar PV), energy storage (eg. batteries) and low carbon building methods (eg. PassivHaus).

Homeowners will indicate when they wish to welcome visitors and will know exactly who the visitors are before they visit. Up to 4 visitors will be allowed per 45 minute slot.

Trees for Grafton Parish Update

A grant of £2,000 has been received from Wessex Water's Environmental Fund to plant further trees in the Parish to replace those felled from Ash Dieback. With the help of the Pewsey Community Area Partnership (PCAP), the set up required to receive a grant was completed and the application was submitted.

Key to getting the grant was all the work in fundraising and planting that has already taken place by Grafton Parish as it demonstrated how the community worked together to raise funds and replace the felled ash trees in our Parish.

The funds received will go towards replacing the 40 trees recently lost in Wexcombe. As with those already planted on the Wilton/Grafton road, 20 of these will be replaced with whips and a further 20 more will be more mature trees. This will be progressed over the coming weeks, with the plan to plant the trees in the autumn.

There will be further planting in the rest of the Parish, as and when required, to replace any trees removed. Fundraising will also restart later in the year and, now that we have the financial and policy set up for the group, we will continue to take advantage of any other grants that become available.

This is a great result for the whole community. Thank you again to everyone who contributed to the fund, to PCAP and to our farmers for supporting and helping with this project.

The Grafton/Wilton new trees are being carefully looked after and monitored. The weather has of course been incredibly challenging for the new trees - cold, rain and then extreme heat and ferocious winds have battered the poor trees, particularly the limes.

Some of them look very sorry for themselves and look like they are turning up their toes. We are aware that they don't look their best but they are being watered and checked on a regular basis - thanks to everyone who has been doing the checking.

Our supplier is also checking on them periodically and wants to reassure everyone that if they do not recover, these will be replaced free of charge later in the year at no cost to the group.

Fingers crossed though that they can get themselves sorted out before the winter hits! The liquidambar seems to be doing a little better than the limes but we remain positive that with a little TLC they will all be in good health this time next year.
