## **A Message from Wilton Windmill Society**

Ever since I have been involved with the Mill, my first glimpse of her has always been from between the trees on Grafton-Wilton Avenue. A lovely rural vista.

The distress I felt was palpable when I drove down that road one day last Summer and found that the bulk of the trees had been felled on account of ash dieback.

The trees stood on the land of Farmer David Lemon and we, at the Mill, feel a huge and ongoing debt to him on account of the free and generous access he affords us to his field lying adjacent to the Mill. Having access to free and plentiful parking has made visits to the Mill and the staging of events so so much easier.

When I heard that the Parish were actively fund raising to help replace the felled trees I immediately felt that the Mill should help.

We have therefore donated £1000 to go towards the purchase of replacement trees on the Grafton-Wilton Avenue in the hope that future generations will once again enjoy that iconic view through these newly planted trees.

#### **News from Sunflowers**





In response to significant changes in the wraparound care landscape on both a national and local level, we have opened Breakfast at Bedwyn. This is a super collaboration with Great Bedwyn Primary School - for Sunflowers a great way to develop the wraparound care we offer in The TreeHouse and for school to benefit of a breakfast club on site.

At home in East Grafton our successful After School Clubs continue along with Breakfast Club for Burbage Primary School. If you have a background in education and an interest in wraparound care we'd love to talk to you about helping to further develop our wraparound care.

The various measures we have taken to strengthen security around our grounds are looking a bit more obvious now that our new gates and fencing are in. Along with the (fairly drastic) work to reduce the height and depth of the hedge carried out in January, our frontage is looking very much smarter. More importantly it has significantly opened up our grounds - which was the objective - all small steps towards strengthening security.

Recruitment is front of mind: you can see our advert for Breakfast at Bedwyn on the front page; we're looking for help to develop our wraparound care; and for qualified early years professionals for our nursery rooms.

You may know that in our nursery rooms we are required to maintain minimum adult: child ratios, for example 1 adult for every 3 babies and tots under 2 years old. But alongside this we also have to maintain ratios of qualified:unqualified team members.


