

Respecting the 80 year D-Day Anniversary

Gigaclear Works



Even though we were taken by surprise by the arrival of Gigaclear on The Green; it is a great result for East Grafton and Wilton to have full fibre broadband on the doorstep, and well worth any disruption.

Wexcombe and Marten already have full fibre due to Village action a few years ago, which leaves only West Grafton not to be connected from this installation. Fill-in works between villages will occur in the future, once further Government funding has been received.

When it is fully installed a broadband checker will show full fibre options for our postcodes. You should be able to move to a full fibre package with your existing or new provider (subject to any tie-in you may have).

The theft and destruction of our second minibus on Easter Monday knocked us sideways. Since then we have been buoyed by many kind messages and offers of help which have combined to create a great big hug around us. Thank you all.

It is hard to believe that we have had 2 vehicles stolen in 7 months and means that we have some serious thinking and planning to do on how we recover and move forward positively. We now have ahead of us a significant period of fundraising. The vehicle stolen at Easter was owned by Sunflowers and so our fundraising pot is started with the insurance claim, but this is by no means the full amount to fill the empty parking spot and activity is underway to explore funding and grants. Alongside this we need to consider how we layer additional security measures.

These thefts have been dreadful but we are managing through the consequences and are delighted that we have been able to avoid any significant impact on our service levels across nursery, wraparound care and holiday clubs. Onwards and upwards!

Surgery News

We are excited to welcome two lovely new staff members:

Lisa who has joined the reception/ admin team and is currently training to do phlebotomy clinics, and Caroline who is working both in the dispensary and reception/admin team. Please be patient with them while they are new and getting used to the systems. There is a huge amount for them to learn!

We also have 2 very experienced Clinical Pharmacists working closely with us, Rima and Shalini. They help us on Tuesdays and Thursdays by dealing with your medication queries and carrying out your medication reviews - which are done over the phone. Please call us if you would like us to book you in with them. You can also now book them online with for a telephone medication review if you get a recall on your repeat slip when you collect your prescription. They are not based here in the surgery so please do not attend for any appointments. They will call you and deal with it by phone.

Prescription Ordering

Please allow plenty of time when re-ordering your medication. With all the Bank Holidays we lose days available for processing them, so ideally need a week's notice.

We are also being inundated with requests from people who have forgotten to order, and are therefore about to run out, who effectively end up jumping the queue! Please do try and plan ahead to help us.
