	presentation of the figures, the request for exemption from full audit (available for small Parish Councils only)
	and the publication of "Rights to Inspect on" all noticeboards.
	The finances are in good order although Mr Bentley expressed concern, following the purchase of new
	defibrillators, that fund raising might be needed in the future if the Council was to maintain its' stated objective
	of keeping the precept below £10k.

### LFHIG: traffic and roadway issues

- Rumble strips will be improved after the A338 has been resurfaced (by the end of 2024)
- Requests for traffic speed checks across the Green in East Grafton have been submitted to Wiltshire Council.
- Caution horse riding signs have been requested for the A338 (Burbage and Hungerford) no further action required
- Re-request for parking restrictions on Wilton Road has been submitted onbehalf of a parishioner.
   Response awaited from Wiltshire Council
- o **Action:** Progress speed traffic survey for the Green. Revisit parking control.

#### Defibrillators

- o A full report was supplied by Mr Burke. This will be published with the AGM documents in CNews
- Action: Mr Bentley agreed to act as deputy when Mr Burke is not available to order parts etc. Mr Burke
  to identify those parts of the replaced units which might be useful and to explore the availability of 2
  further units to replace the remaining originals. This may need fundraising.

- Trees on Green , East Grafton not discussed due to lack of detail available
- Neighbourhood Watch Mr Pash described burglaries in Martin.
